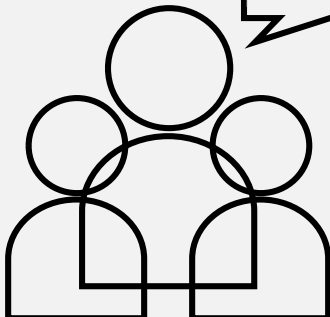
Begin Sukkah Preparations
